How Does an As-Is Sale Work in California?

- Disclosure: California law still requires sellers to provide full disclosures (such as the Transfer Disclosure Statement) about the property's condition.
- Inspection: Buyers can (and usually will) inspect the property, but as the seller, you aren't required to make repairs.
- Closing: As-is transactions often close quickly. Reputable buyers will outline any costs or terms up front—there should be no hidden fees.

When Not to Sell As-Is

- Only minor repairs needed and have time to fix them? You may get more selling the traditional way.
- As-is is best if you want speed, convenience, or to skip repair costs.
